

KINGDOM ALIGNMENT CHECKLIST

Establishing the Kingdom Within

"Align the heart and clear the space, to make my soul His dwelling place."

- ☐ **The "Father" Lens: Am I viewing my current struggle as an "attack" or as a "training session" from my Father?**

In moments of hardship, our natural instinct is to feel targeted or punished. This requires you to pause and reframe the situation. Instead of asking, "Why is this happening to me?" ask, "What is my Father teaching me through this?" By applying this lens of grace, you acknowledge that discipline is proof of your sonship and a requirement for your future authority.

- ☐ **The Mirror Check: Did I look in the "Mirror" of Scripture today, and did I actually change what it revealed?**

It is easy to collect knowledge without ever changing your behavior. Just as you wouldn't look in a mirror, see a smudge, and walk away, you must look at the Word and identify one specific area that needs "washing." If the Word reveals pride, the action is humility; if it reveals fear, the action is trust. True integrity is in the application.

- ☐ **The "Sacrifice" Check: Am I trying to hide a lack of obedience behind a lot of "religious work"?**

We often try to compensate for a lack of obedience in one area by being "extra religious" in another. This audit asks you to look for "hollow sacrifices"—like giving money or time to mask the fact that you are refusing to forgive someone or let go of a specific sin. God desires the alignment of the heart over the performance of the hands.

- ☐ **The Street Execution: What is one specific command I've been ignoring that I will "Keep" today?**

Pick one specific instruction from the King that you have been procrastinating on and take it "into the street." Obedience is time-sensitive; delayed obedience is still a form of disobedience. This means making a phone call, changing a business practice, or adjusting your daily routine today to align with the Light of the true King.

- ☐ **The Legacy Filter: Am I participating in the Great Reversal through my daily submission?**

Your obedience is part of a larger Prophetic Timeline. Just as Christ's "Yes" reversed Adam's "No," your daily choices to stay disciplined affect the generations behind you. This step ensures you are looking past your current comfort and toward your ultimate goal: Salvation and the restoration of the Kingdom.
